No. M-TPT/17/2023-DoTPT-DT: It is hereby reiterated again for information of the General Public of the State that the e-Challan system in the state was launched by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 20th September 2020. Notification in this regard was issued and put in place vide notification no. DT-72/E-Challan/2019 dated 29th September, 2020.

- 2. Accordingly, it has become mandatory that collection of fines and penalties for violation of the provision of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 is to be processed entirely through the e-Challan system, making the entire process more efficient and accurate. This step also marked the complete transition to a digital system for handling traffic violations. No physical challan is to be entertained by General Public.
- 3. Fines and penalties can be easily paid through online platform on the basis of fines & penalties generated through e-Challan devices, thereby offering a secure and convenient method for settlement without the need to visit physical counters of Traffic and Transport Offices.
