No. 13/1/91-T(MV) Pt: Whereas, in exercise conferred by section 111 (2)(d) and section 211 of the MV Act' 1988 (59 of 1988), the State Government proposes to amend the Motor Vehicles (Fourth Amendment) Rules for Manipur ' 1997.

Now, therefore the draft **Motor Vehicles (Pollution under Control) Rules for Manipur' 2019** are hereby published as required under sub-section 1 of section 212 of the said Act for information to all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft Rules will be taken into consideration by the Government on or after the expiry of 30 (thirty) days from the dated of publication of the Notification in the official Gazette.

Any person who is willing to raise any objections/suggestions in writing to the Secretary (Transport), Govt. of Manipur within 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Notification in the official Gazette.

Any objections/suggestions received after the said stipulated period shall not be entertained.

DRAFT MOTOR VEHICLES (POLLUTION UNDER CONTROL) RULES FOR MANIPUR' 2019:

1. Short title and commencement, -(i) These rules may be called the **Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules for Manipur' 2017**

(ii) They shall come into force from the dated their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Amendment of Rule 198,- For sub-rule (1) of rule 198 of the Motor Vehicles Rules for Manipur, 1951, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"198 (i) Testing fee for smoke emission level and carbon monoxide level for Motor Vehicles.

(a) The fee for testing shall be

(i) 2 & 3 wheelers (both petrol & diesel driven) @ Rs. 50/-

(ii) 4 wheelers /light motor vehicles (both petrol & diesel driven) @ Rs. 75/-

(iii) 4 wheelers/medium vehicles (both petrol & diesel driven) @ Rs 85/-

(iv) Heavy vehicles (bus & trucks) @ Rs 100/-

(b) Fee for re-testing after rectification

(i) 2 & 3 wheelers (both petrol & diesel driven) @ Rs. 30/-

(ii) 4 wheelers /light motor vehicles (both petrol & diesel driven) @ Rs. 50/-

(iii) 4 wheelers/medium vehicles (both petrol & diesel driven) @ Rs 70/-

(iv) Heavy vehicles (bus & trucks) @ Rs 80/-

"198 (ii) For the purpose of sub-rule (i), the following officers/staff of the motor vehicles Department & Manipur pollution control board shall be the testing officers:-

(a) Motor Vehicles Department:

(i) Motor Vehicles Inspectors(Mechanical/Enforcement)

(ii) Sub- Inspectors (Enforcement)

(iii) Assistant Sub- Inspectors (Enforcement)

Remarks: The Enforcement officers listed above shall have to undergo proper training on handling the testing machines (smoke meter & gas analyser) to be imparted by the service engineers of the manufacturer/supplier concerned or by the Mechanical Inspectors of the Transport Department who are handling /manning the Smoke Testing Centres from time to time

(b) Manipur Pollution Control Board:

(i) Not below the rank of Junior Environmental Engineers(Mech)/ Smoke Testers(equivalent to SO/ Grade -III)
